- If the storm water piping in the new estates to the West were connected to the lake it may not be necessary to fill the lake from the Goulburn river system. This was mentioned several years ago to a council official but was ignored.
- With the new houses being built on the lake and the state of the land on the estate it really detracts from the beauty of the lake.
- The irrigation system to fill the lake is a disgrace and needs a fence around it to stop children climbing on to that area as it is highly dangerous.
- Lights are needed at the corner of Craigmuir Drive and Echuca Road as it is very hard for cars to see the Craigmuir Drive sign at night and when walking in early morning and evening not enough lighting for walkers to see the footpath.
- Walking paths need to be repaired and made safer for those who walk around the lake and the new subdivisions. A lot of elderly people use this for daily walking and is highly dangerous in some spots.
