

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Arcadia Recreation Reserve draft Master Plan - Background Paper



June 2015

1. Background to the Master Plan

The Arcadia Recreation Reserve Committee of Management identified the need to develop a master plan for the Reserve. The Arcadia Locality Plan Group has supported this project as a high priority for the community due to the importance the Reserve plays within the local community.

The reserve is the only public facility currently available to support important social connections. Social tennis, Australia Day festivities, Christmas activities and farmers markets take place at the Reserve. Both the CFA and Landcare are active community groups within Arcadia and are based at the Reserve.

Like most small towns, a school, hotel, railway station and shops once existed to support the thriving local economy and community. These services and infrastructure no longer exist.

The impact of a changing economy and modernisation such as the modern car, many residents now travel away from Arcadia to support employment, recreation and social needs. Therefore, the reserve plays an important role in supporting social connections within the local community.

2. Current Facilities

The Reserve provides the following facilities:

- Tennis Court
- Playground
- CFA Shed
- Community Centre
- Open Space with mature trees.
- A small area of the site is leased to a neighbour for stock.

3. Issues and Opportunities

Community needs identified in relation to the Reserve include:

- Bollards aged and in need of replacement, potential safety issue
- Car Parking –a safety issue exists currently where cars park anywhere throughout the reserve
- Landscaping regular mulching, further plantings needed and watering options needed
- Toilet facilities not accessible and aged
- Peppercorn trees non-native trees
- History history of the area is not captured in the town
- CFA shed limited space for new vehicle
- Recreation facilities limited limited facilities exist at the reserve to support the communities recreation needs
- Small town off the main road no evidence of links with Greater Shepparton within the town
- Playground has no shade
- Walking tracks there are limited opportunities for walking tracks leading out and around the town and linking up to the Reserve.
