

5. SAM Director's Report:

5.1 Sidney Myer Fund Australian Ceramic Award 2019

RC informed the Advisory Committee that the opening event on Friday 21 June 2019 was a well-attended and very successful event and the Sidney Myer Catalogue being finalised.

RC noted that the winner's artwork will be acquired as well as some works from other artists from the Sidney Myer Australian Ceramic Award.

5.2 Exhibitions

5.3 Collections and potential Loans

SAM has been approached to loan works by Margaret Preston and Grace Cossington Smith for an upcoming exhibition in the US, coordinated by ASNSW.
